



## REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS

The Harrisonburg-Rockingham Regional Sewer Authority (HRRSA) will be accepting Sealed Proposals until Thursday, January 15, 2015, 2:00 P.M., local time, 856 North River Road, Mt. Crawford, Virginia 22841, at which time only the names of the offerors will be read for the following project to be performed at HRRSA's North River Wastewater Treatment Facility (WWTF):

### BIOREACTOR BLOWER EQUIPMENT PROCUREMENT

HRRSA will evaluate, select and directly purchase from one (1) manufacturer, for permanent installation, two fully functional, pretested, factory assembled High Speed Turbo (HST) blowers and control systems to meet the requirements contained in this Request for Proposals (RFP) document, Technical Specifications and Project Drawings. HRRSA shall also have the option to purchase a third HST blower.

HRRSA will also have the option to select and rent from one manufacturer, for a temporary installation period not less than three months and no greater than twelve months, a fully functional, pretested, factory assembled centrifugal blower system that meets the technical and performance requirements in the RFP.

HRRSA will either self-perform or under separate contract(s) procure the services of general contractor(s) to perform the necessary work to install the blower equipment. Both the permanent and temporary blowers will be installed under the direction of the manufacturer's field representative.

Information concerning this solicitation is contained in the Request for Proposals (RFP) document, RFP No. HRRSA-2015-03. Copies of the RFP, Technical Specifications, and Project Drawings are available for public inspection at HRRSA's Administration Building, 856 North River Road, Mt. As described in the RFP, HRRSA will review and rank the proposals based upon the following factors: manufacturer information, relevant experience and references; response to RFP technical requirements; guaranteed delivery schedule; compliance with all aspects of the RFP (cause for rejection) and project cost.

Any changes to the RFP will be in the form of written addendum, which will be furnished to all prospective offerors who have been issued specifications. HRRSA shall not be held responsible for any oral instructions.
