

**HARRISONBURG-ROCKINGHAM REGIONAL SEWER AUTHORITY (HRRSA)
WASTE ACCEPTANCE RULES AND REGULATIONS**

1. Waste Hauling Contractors must receive written approval from HRRSA before disposing of any wastes at this facility. A list of approved contractors will be maintained at this facility.
2. Only domestic household septage will be accepted. Each Hauler will be required to sign a discharge report certifying to this fact and providing information on the source of the septage. Waste from industrial users/manufacturers is unacceptable, unless receiving prior written approval. Each driver will record origin, address and daylight telephone number of all waste dumped. Wastes from restaurant grease pits will be accepted only from Harrisonburg and Rockingham County.
3. All septage will be dumped at HRRSA designated dump sites.
4. Haulers shall check in with the plant operator on duty prior to unloading. An HRRSA employee will be present at each discharge. **Septage will be taken during the following hours: 7:00 A.M. -11:30 A.M., 1:00 P.M. - 6:00 P.M., and 7:00 P.M. - 10:00 P.M.**
5. A sample may be collected, tested and/or retained from each load for compliance monitoring.
6. Buffering chemicals (lime, etc.,) may necessarily be added and mixed before dumping. Cost of such chemicals will be borne by the Hauler.
7. All Haulers will be required to provide their own equipment necessary to unload into the wastewater treatment facility.
8. Any spillage that occurs will be cleaned up by the Hauler.
9. Haulers will be billed monthly for use of the system based on the volume of loads accepted during the previous month.
10. Any infraction of HRRSA rules or regulations will be grounds for refusal to accept waste from the Hauler.
11. The plant operator on duty shall have the authority to refuse to accept a specific load. The decision of the Executive Director shall be final in all matters in which disputes arise.
12. Waste disposal may be suspended if warranted by facility operational problems.

*The fee for septage disposal is (Harrisonburg/Rockingham County) \$60.00/1,000 gallons. (Outside Rockingham County) \$100.00/1,000 gallons.

In addition to these fees, fees for compliance monitoring, chemicals, clean-up, etc., will be added as necessary.
